## 2006 Catalina 22 National Sailing Association Championship Regatta "GOLD RUSH 2006" JUNE 19<sup>TH</sup> TO JUNE 22<sup>ND</sup>

Catalina 22 Fleet 54 and the Gold Country Yacht Club (GCYC) are pleased to invite you to compete in the 2006 Catalina 22 National Championship Regatta held on Scotts Flat Lake in Nevada City, Ca.

- RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008*; the Constitution and By-Laws of the Catalina 22 National Sailing Association; the Catalina 22 One-Design Class Rules effective March 29, 2005; the Sailing Instructions dated 1-02-06 and the Notice of Race dated 10-31-05 shall apply.
- ADVERTISING:** Advertising will be restricted to Category A.
- ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:** The regatta is open to all boats of the Catalina 22 Class. Skipper/Helmsman must be a Catalina 22 National Sailing Association member in good standing on or before April 19, 2006. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form published in the January 2006 MainBrace issue or the entry form available on the Catalina 22 National Website at [www.catalina22.org](http://www.catalina22.org) or at the Gold Country Yacht Club website at [www.gcyc.net](http://www.gcyc.net). On-site entry forms will be accepted as shown on #5 in the NOTICE OF RACE dated 10-31-05.
- FEES:** Required fees are as follows:

6. **MEASUREMENTS:** Each boat shall produce a valid Catalina 22 One-Design Class Measurement certificate before close of registration. The Catalina 22 National Sailing Association Chief Measurer or his designee shall measure all sails on-site, prior to first day of racing.
7. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The sailing instructions will be available after 01-02-06 on the Catalina 22 National Sailing Associations website at <http://www.catalina22.org>, the Gold Country Yacht Club website at <http://www.gcyc.net> or by mail upon receipt of racing fees after 01-02-06.
8. **THE COURSES:** The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Windward/Leeward with an offset mark and Leeward gate.
9. **PENALTY SYSTEM:** Rule 44.1 shall apply.
10. **SCORING:** A minimum of four (4) races shall be completed for the Catalina 22 National Sailing Association Championship title. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. There will be no "throw-outs". The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A4.1 will apply.
11. **BERTHING:** Boats shall be kept in their assigned places. Dry Storage and daily launching/retrieval may be required.
12. **PRIZES:** A minimum of five (5) boats per fleet will constitute the awarding of trophies. The Betty Gay Clements perpetual trophy will be awarded to the highest placing woman skipper in accordance with its deed.
13. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, its' sponsors or Nevada Irrigation District will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
