1. **Rules:** the regatta will be governed by the rules as define in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009 – 2012*, the *Catalina 22 One Design Rules*, this *Notice of Race*, and the *Sailing Instructions for the Gold Country Yacht Club 29th Annual Go For the Gold Regatta*.
2. **Advertising:** advertising will be restricted to Category A
3. **Classes:** Catalina 22 boats with four fleets as defined below, with a minimum of five boats registered to make a fleet.
4. **Fleets:** Gold is open to all skipper levels to compete for the title of 2010 Far West Region 10 Champion Skipper, Silver is open to all skippers who have not won a trophy in any C22 National Association sanctioned Region, State or National Catalina 22 Regatta. Minimum Weight is open to all skippers with boats manufactured by Catalina Yachts after hull #13343 to hull #15539. Spinnaker is open to all skippers registered for the Spinnaker Fleet.
5. **Eligibility:** participation in this Catalina 22 Far West Region 10 Championship Regatta in the capacity of skipper/helmsman shall be limited to owners of Catalina 22 boats and their immediate families, who also must be members of Region 10 of the Catalina 22 National Sailing Association in good standing. The registered skipper for the regatta is required to be on board the entered boat during all races.
6. **Registration & Fees:** the registration form and associated fees will be available on the Gold Country Yacht Club web site at www.gcyc.net no later than April 1st, 2010. Early registration will close on June 1st, 2010. A late fee may be assessed after that date. Late registration will close on June 5th 2010 at 1000 hours. A 10% discount for US Sailing members will be offered with proof of US Sailing membership. Receipt of registration will be determined by the postmark on the envelope or when received by the Registrar of the Organizing Authority if hand delivered.

7. Schedule of events:

8. **Measurements:** each boat shall comply with the Catalina 22 One Design Rules and produce a valid Measurement Certificate before close of registration at 10:00 a.m. Saturday June 5th, 2010. The Organizing Authority may perform an inspection of boats at any time during the regatta.
9. **Sailing Instructions:** the *Sailing Instructions* will be accessible no later than May 1st 2010 on the Gold Country Yacht Club web site at www.gcyc.net and provided in the skipper's packet at the Gold Country Yacht Club regatta registration desk at Scotts Flat Lake.
10. **Course:** the courses to be sailed will be a modified Olympic Circle as determined by the Race Committee.
11. **Racing Area:** the racing area will be on Scotts Flat Lake, except in areas designated as swimming areas and mooring areas as described in the *Sailing Instructions*.
12. **Scoring:** the Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A of *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009-2012* will apply. All scores will be counted, with a minimum of one race constituting a regatta.
13. **Amendments to the Notice of Race:** the Organizing Authority reserves the right to amend this *Notice of Race* from time to time. Please check www.gcyc.net or call Region 10 Commodore, Lynn Buchanan, at 530-913-4283 for updates.
14. **Additional Information:** Admittance to Scotts Flat Lake is under the control of the State of California, Department of Boating and Waterways. A fee to enter and launch your boat at Scotts Flat Lake will be collected by Nevada Irrigation District at Gate #2 upon entry. Camping, laundry, fishing boat rentals and a General Store are available at Scotts Flat Lake.
